Below is an example of a message to Mr. Monkhouse in 2018, pleading with him about the health of the grand kids. Lucia Putnam (Mr. Putnam's mother) wrote the letter and received a response from Mr. Monkhouse that he would prefer she not contact him any further.

Dear Bryan,

I am writing this letter to you with great concern for our common grandchildren, Brig, Soren and Reidar. Something is desperately wrong. Our families need to intervene to protect their mental and physical health. Lise-Anne is unilaterally destroying what was a beautiful family-- that was happy together, traveled together, played together, was intellectually most compatible, and was economically well off.

We can not believe what she is doing to the boys and to her professed (to everyone) love of Scott. We would like to be able to talk with you and see what you think of this situation. Everyone- neighbors, friends and the children were totally blindsided by her announcement--it was not just Scott who was blindsided in July. Can you describe an event or cause for this announcement of Lise-Anne? You told Scott when you were visiting in France, "that he was different and than he had changed suddenly". But in Lise-anne's testimony, she says it is the same behavior for 14 years, since when Brig was born. If you know of an event to cause her announcement in July, please tell me because nobody else is aware of any event or transgression.

We are very concerned about the boys health. The head of the twins school says that they are totally nervous and insecure only since the breakup of the family. Soren is having chronic problems with his stomach due to the stress. Lise-Anne had always appeared to be a great mother but now she is living in fear and panic. Her own fear is harming the boys, and she is using them as pawns in her battle for a separation from Scott. We are totally sick about this whole thing and want to help in any way we can ---especially to resolved the damage being done to three beautiful boys. All studies of children show the importance of having a father. They need their Dad, and I can't think of a father who loves his children more or who as taught them so much, such as skiing, hiking, traveling, sailing, water-skiing, tools, computers, etc.

I have read the allegations of violence against Scott, and there is no factual basis for any of it- only Lise-Anne's narrative. The court agrees with the lack of evidence and has dismissed the allegations and protective order. I expect you to be similarly skeptical of the allegations, particularly since you know how Lise-anne could live in her own little world, separated from reality.

I have spent many many weeks with this family-- both after new babies and traveling with them. Just look at those family books LA and Scott made for the years 2014,2015,2016--what could be a better record of their great lives together? It is devastating that she could break it up so suddenly.

Lise-Anne and I have spoken together on the phone almost weekly for years and all of a sudden I am totally out of her life. She told Scott not to have contact with me, and now refuses to talk with me on the phone when I call the boys. Why am I also being kicked out our her life at that same time? While Scott has made numerous efforts at reconciliation, counseling, and friend intervention. Not once has Lise-Anne made an effort at reconciliation. Not a single friend of hers, or her family has reached out at reconciliation and discussion.

Lise-Anne is not acting normally. I know she turned 50 this past June and there may be a hormonal problem, or she is suffering from a mid-life examination of her role as a mother and mathematician. She is living in fear of something, but her fear is destroying a family and future of three wonderful boys. Whatever is going on needs to be resolved in the best possible way to allow the boys to have trust in people for their future lives.
